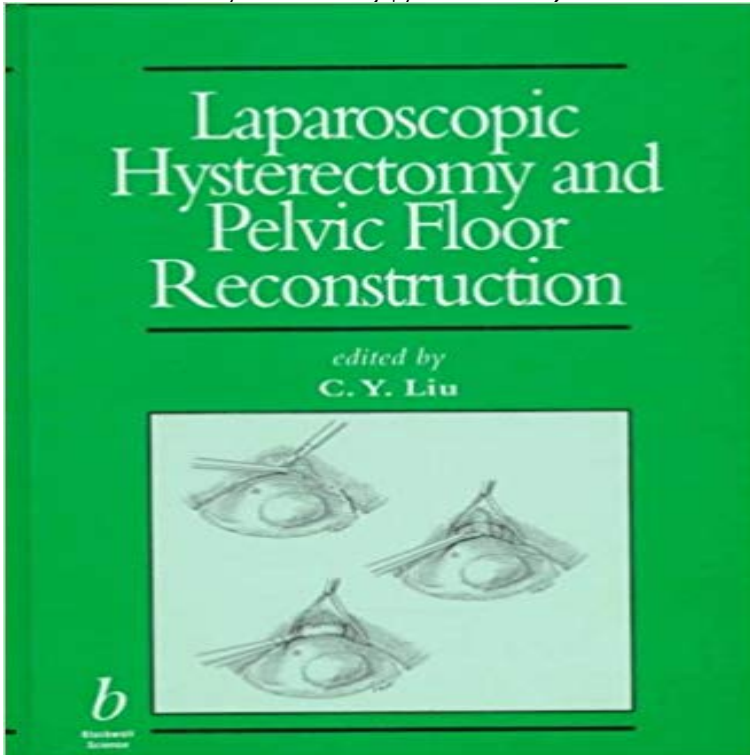


Laparoscopic Hysterectomy and Pelvic Floor Reconstruction (Minimally Invasive Gynecology Series)
