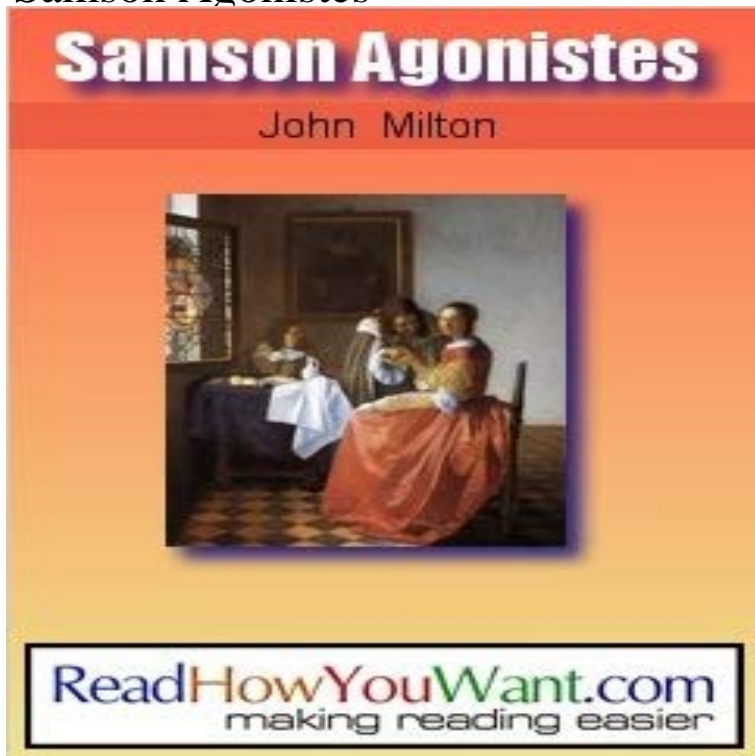


Samson Agonistes
