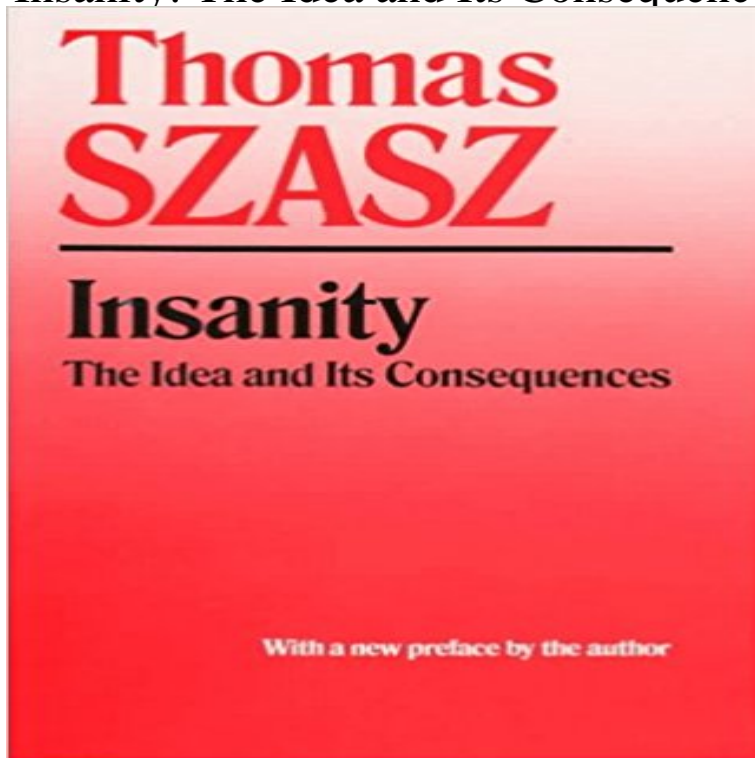


Insanity: The Idea and Its Consequences
