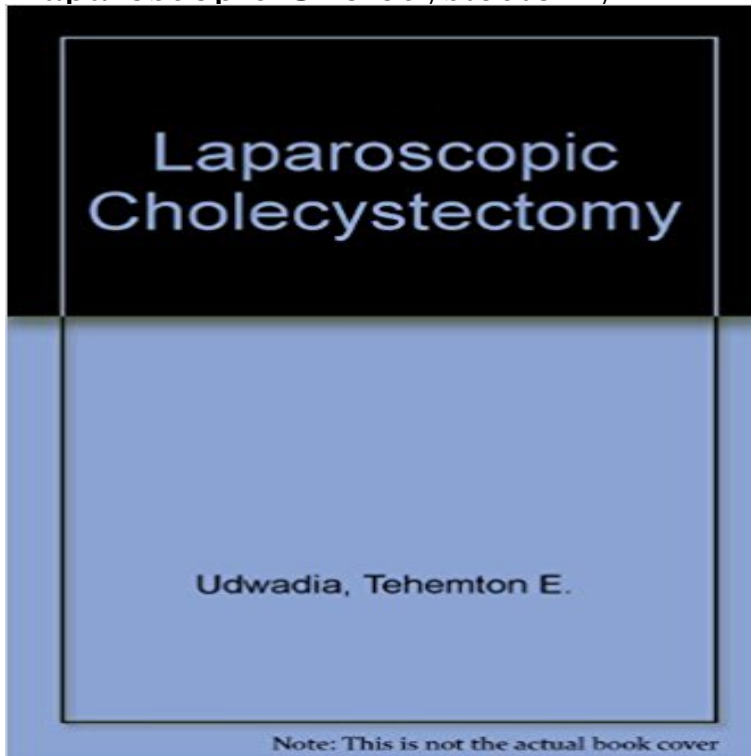


Laparoscopic Cholecystectomy
