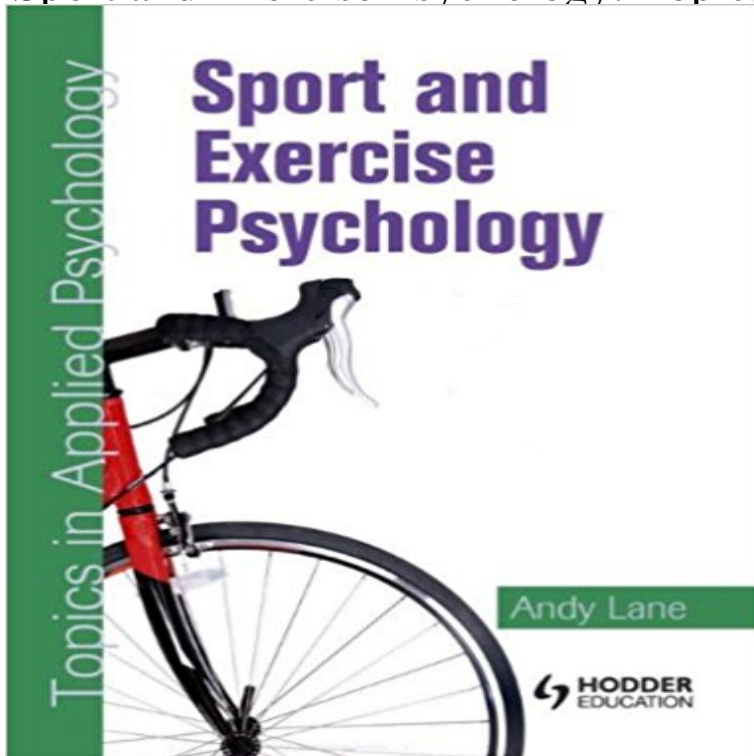


Sport and Exercise Psychology: Topics in Applied Psychology
