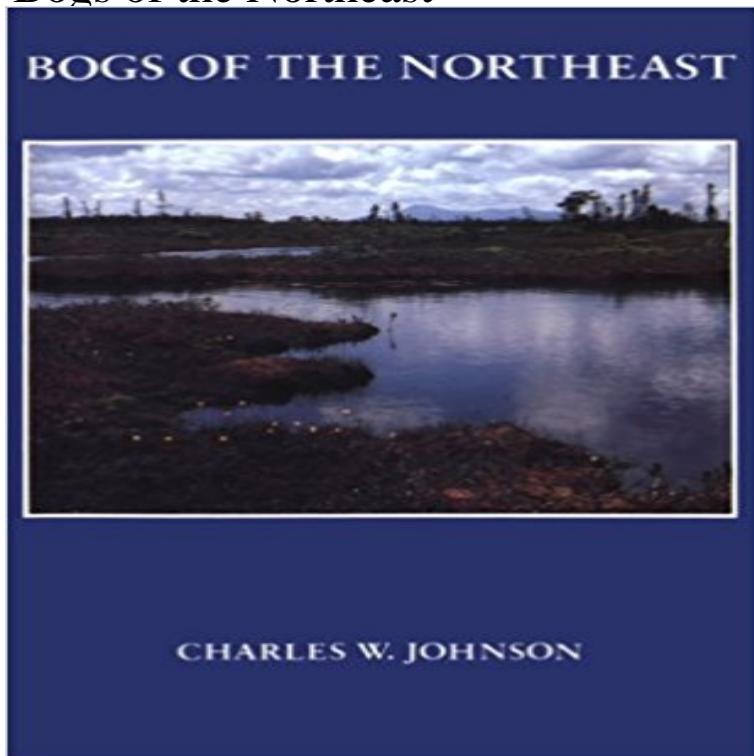


Bogs of the Northeast
