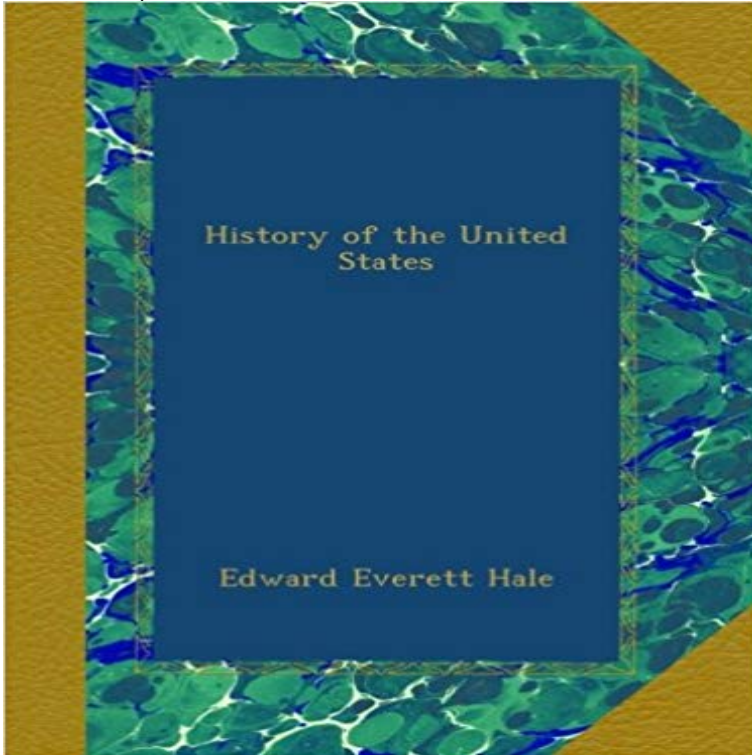


History of the United States
