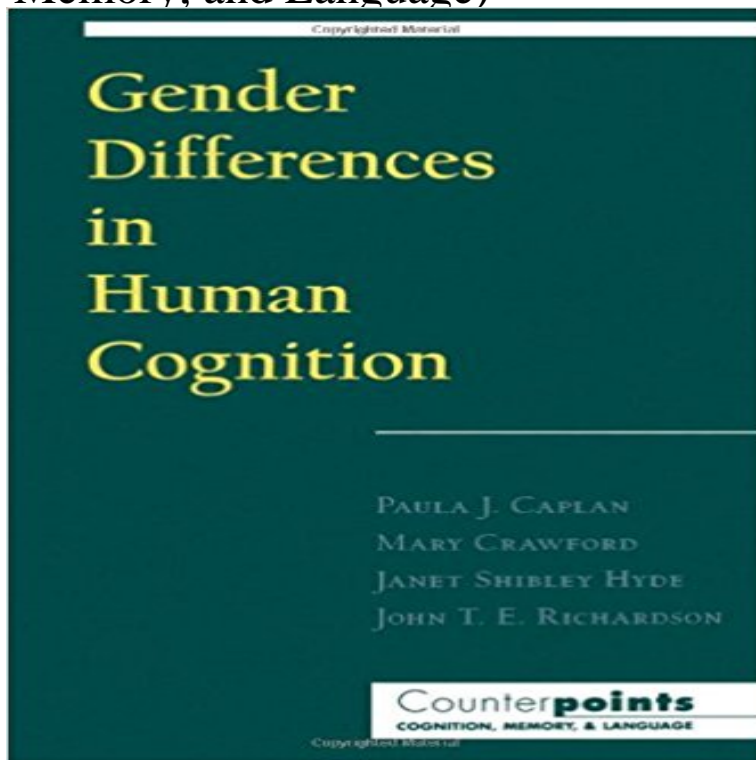


Gender Differences in Human Cognition (Counterpoints: Cognition, Memory, and Language)
