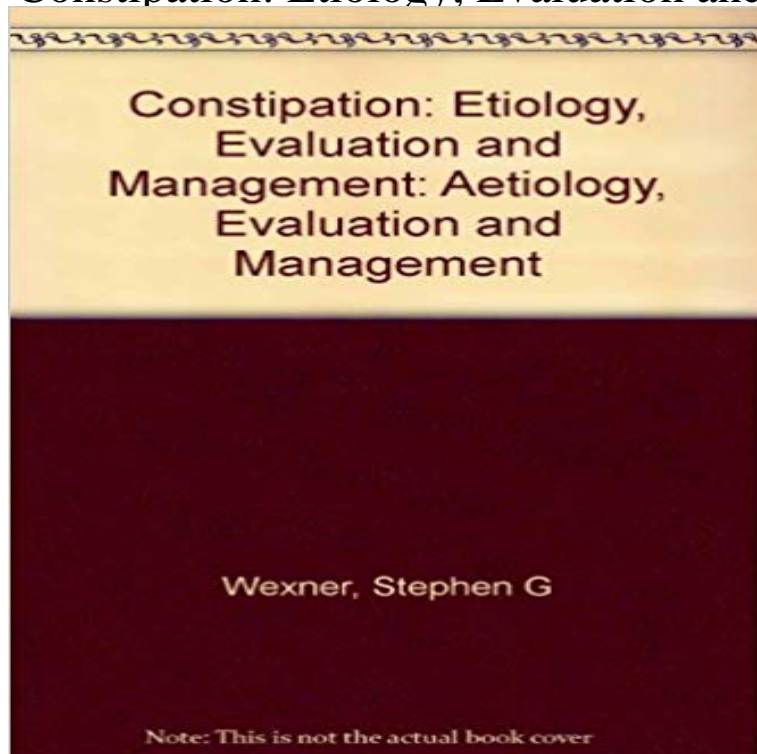


Constipation: Etiology, Evaluation and Management
