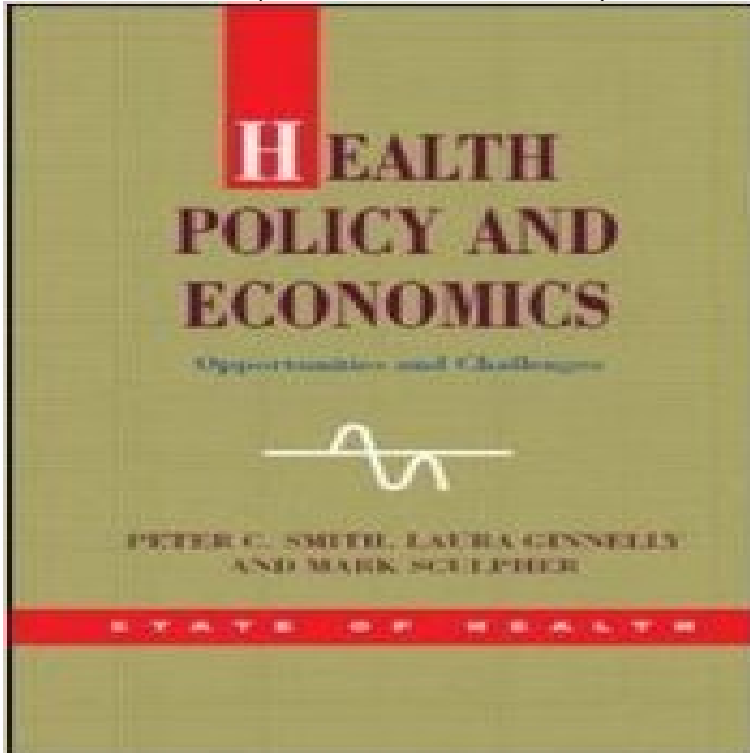


## Health Policy and Economics (State of Health)
