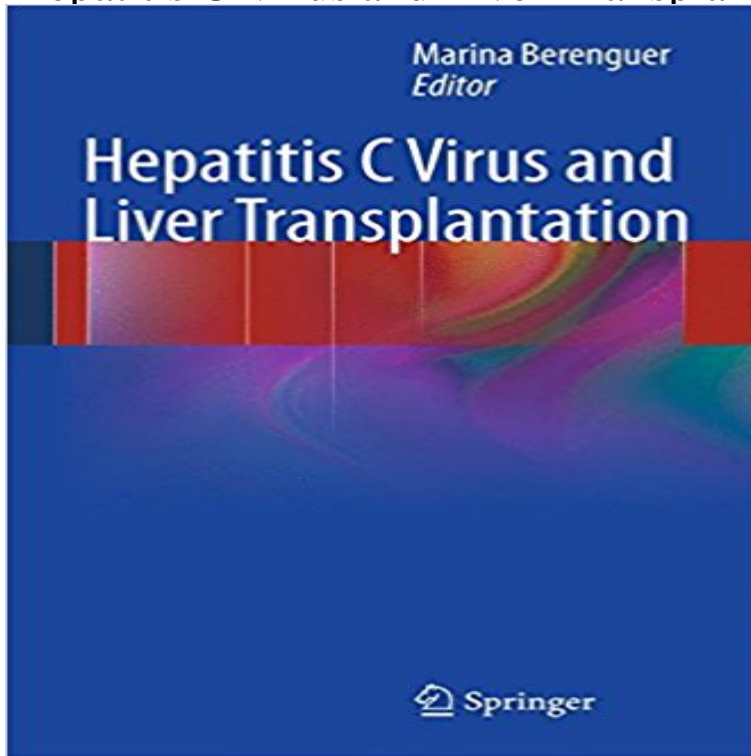


Hepatitis C Virus and Liver Transplantation
