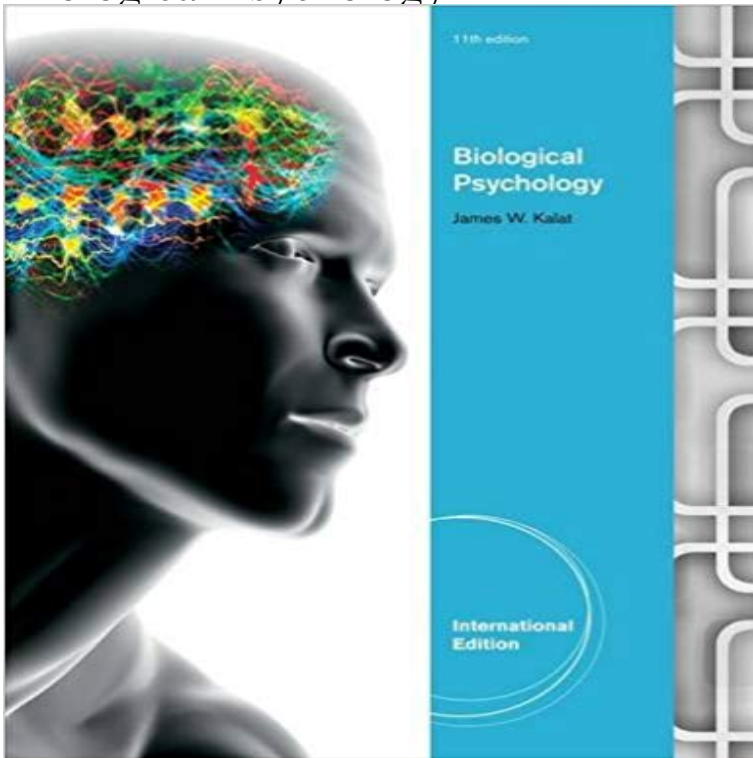


Biological Psychology
