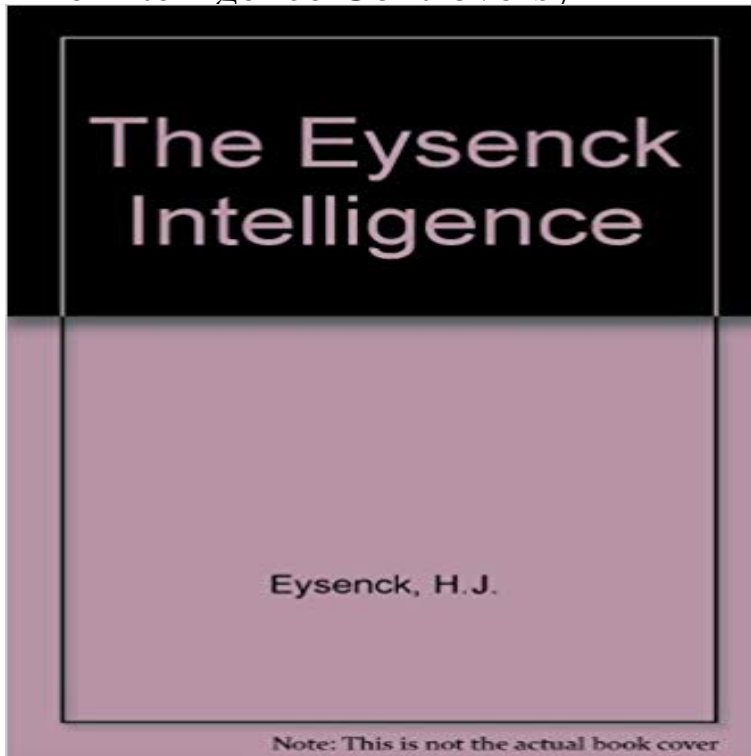


The Intelligence Controversy
