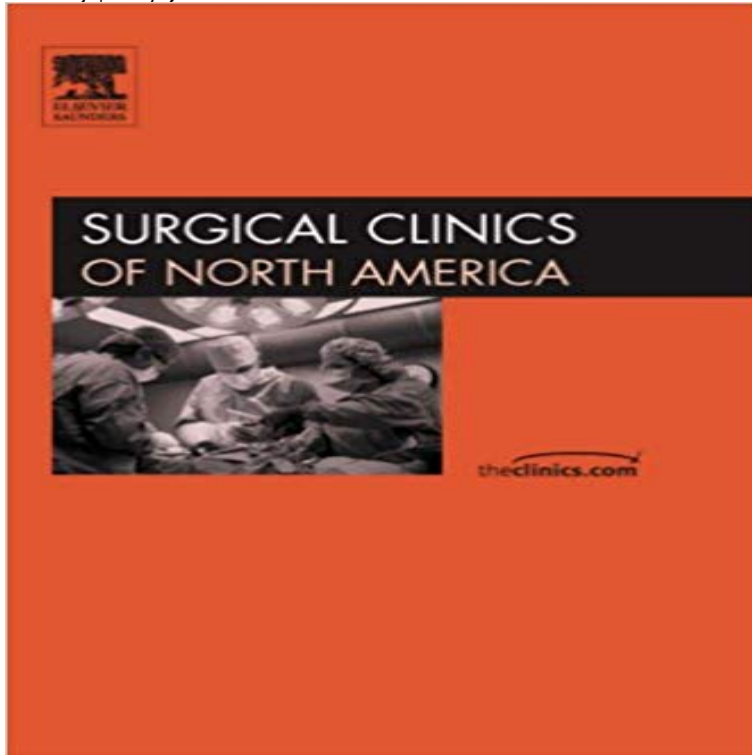


## Trauma Care Today, An Issue of Surgical Clinics, 1e (The Clinics: Surgery)
