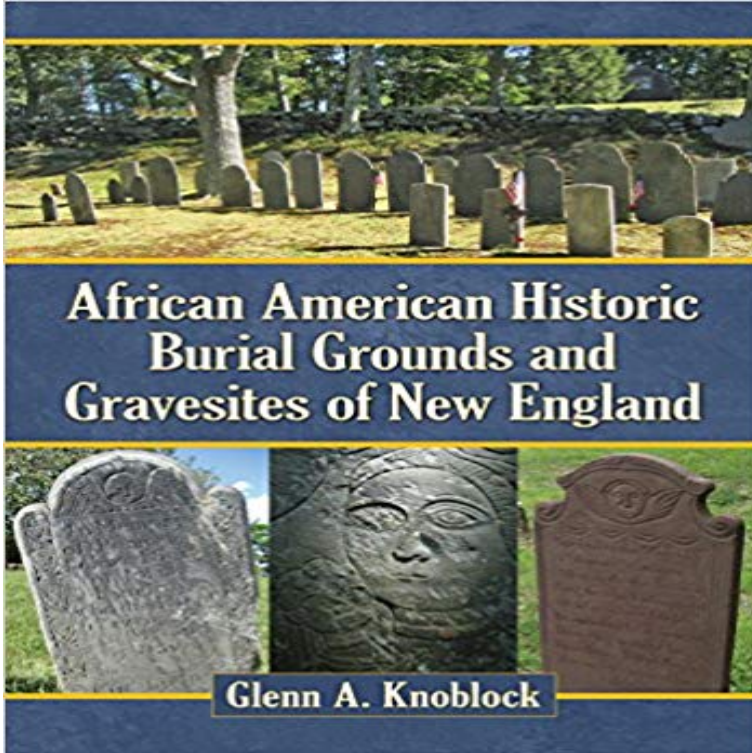


# African American Historic Burial Grounds and Gravesites of New England
