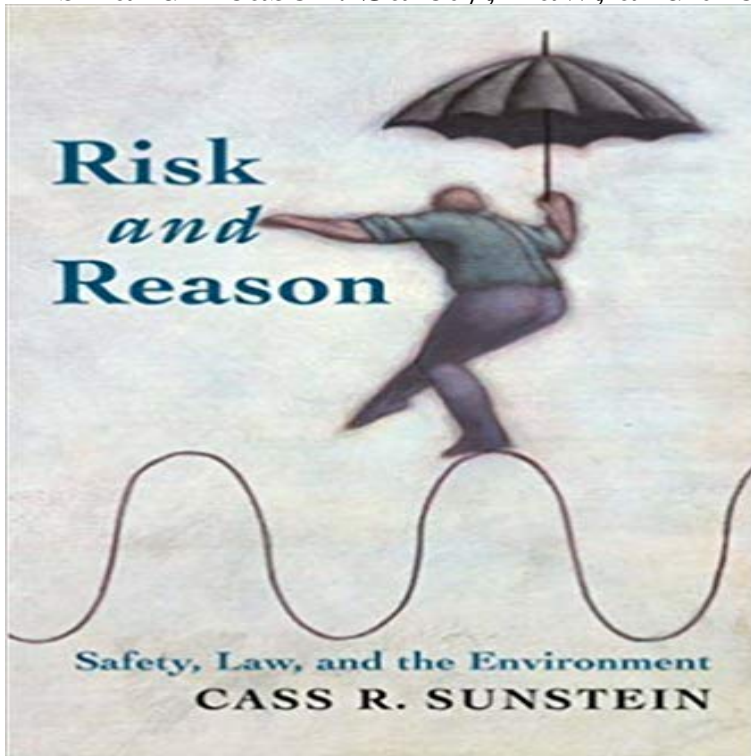


Risk and Reason: Safety, Law, and the Environment
