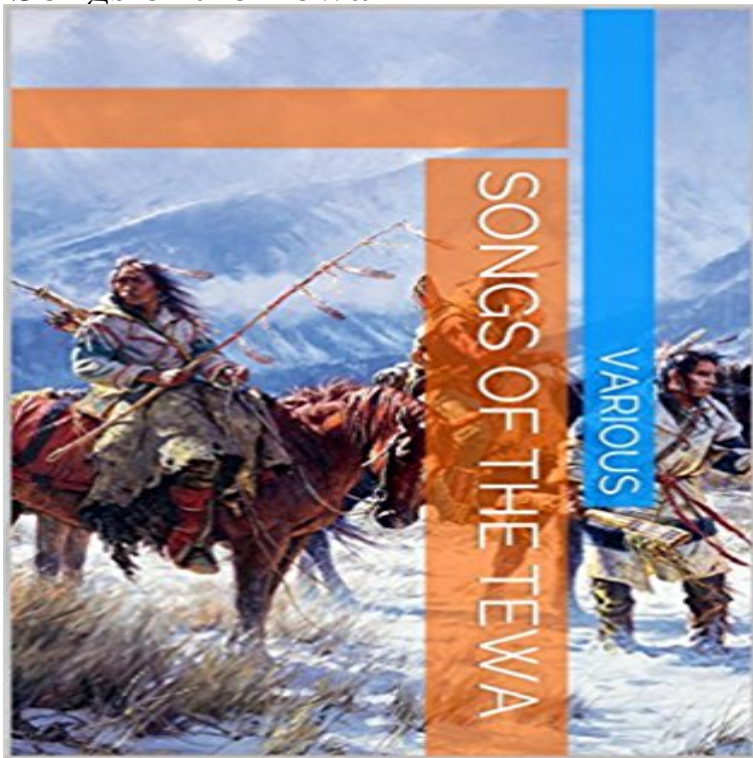


Songs of the Tewa

An appendix has interlinear texts for some of the Tewa songs. The book is preceded by an essay on Native American poetry and literature, including samples from the north to the south of the American continent.
