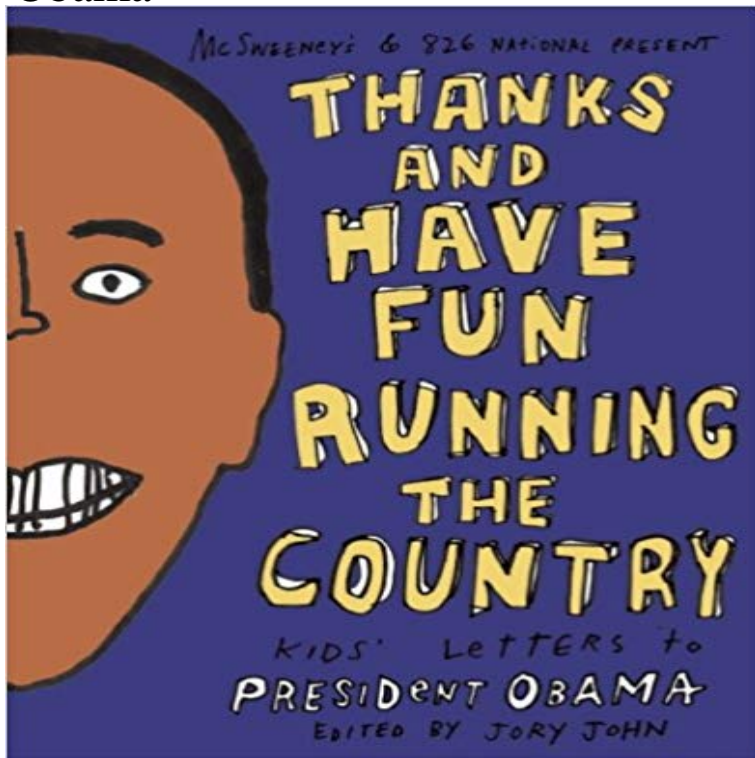


## Thanks and Have Fun Running the Country: Kids Letters to President Obama
