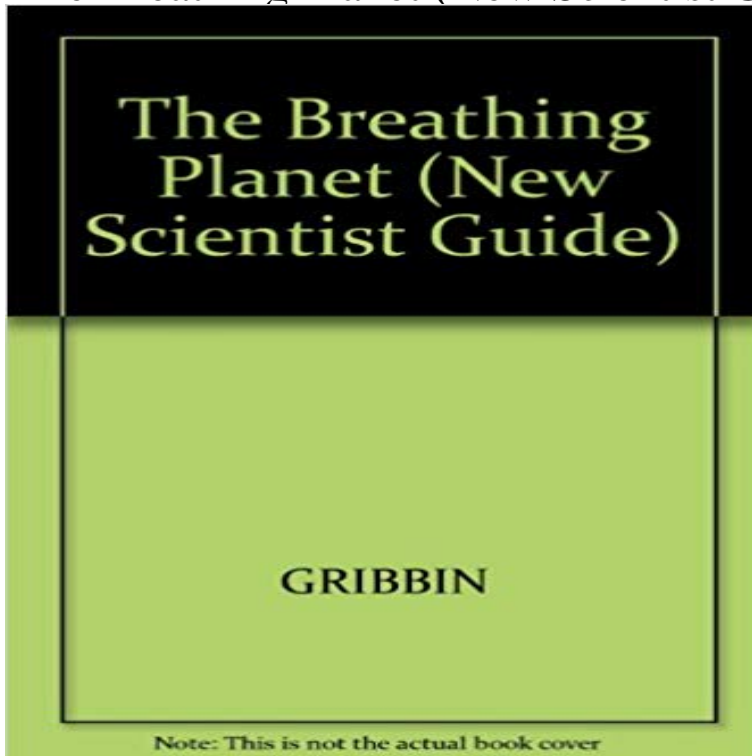


## The Breathing Planet (New Scientist Guide)

The book discusses ice ages past and future, the `greenhouse effect which could bring droughts and floods in our lifetime, and the havoc its destruction could wreak on plant and animal life. John Gribbin vividly illustrates how each element in nature is deeply dependent on every other.
