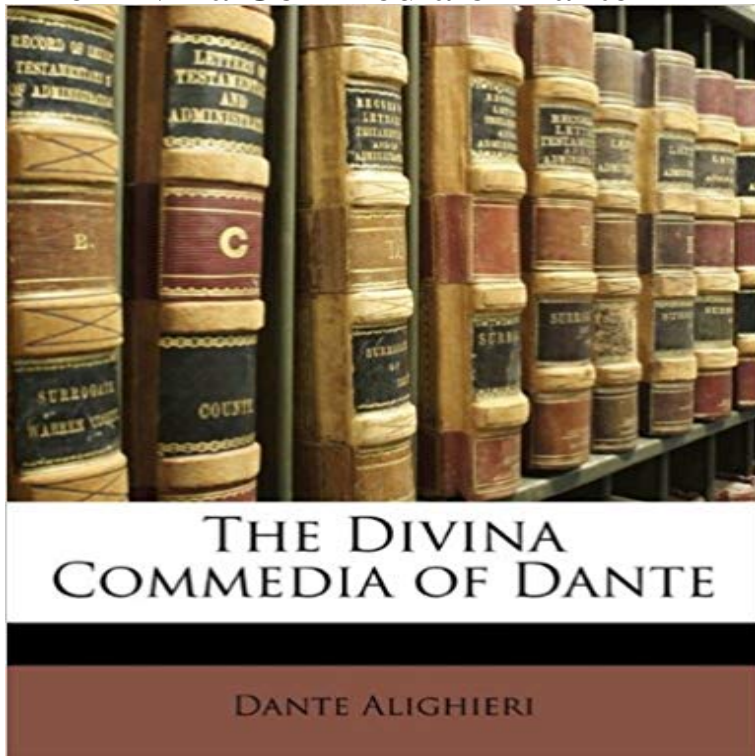


The Divina Commedia of Dante
