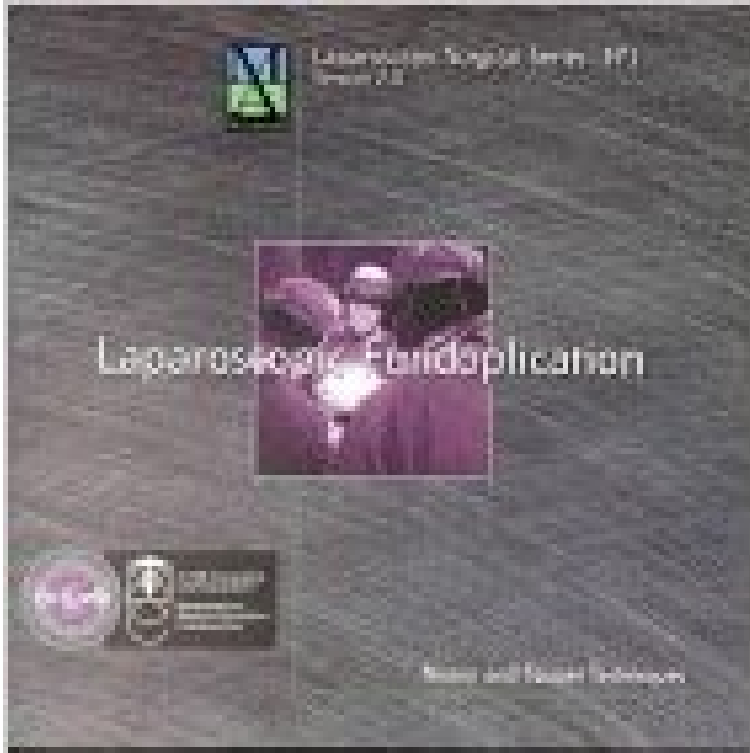


Laparoscopic Fundoplication: Nissen and Toupet Techniques: Laparoscopic Surgical Series
