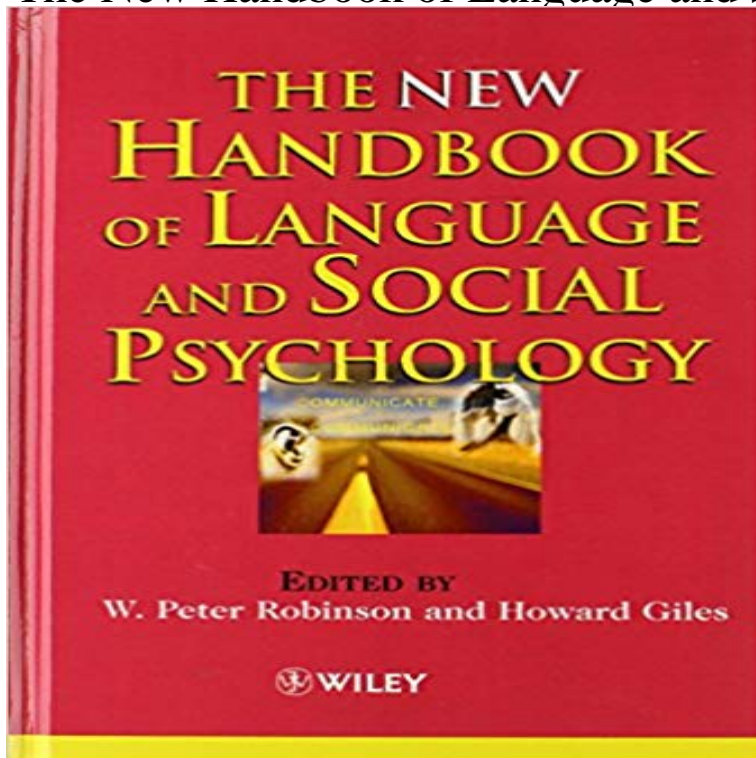


## The New Handbook of Language and Social Psychology
