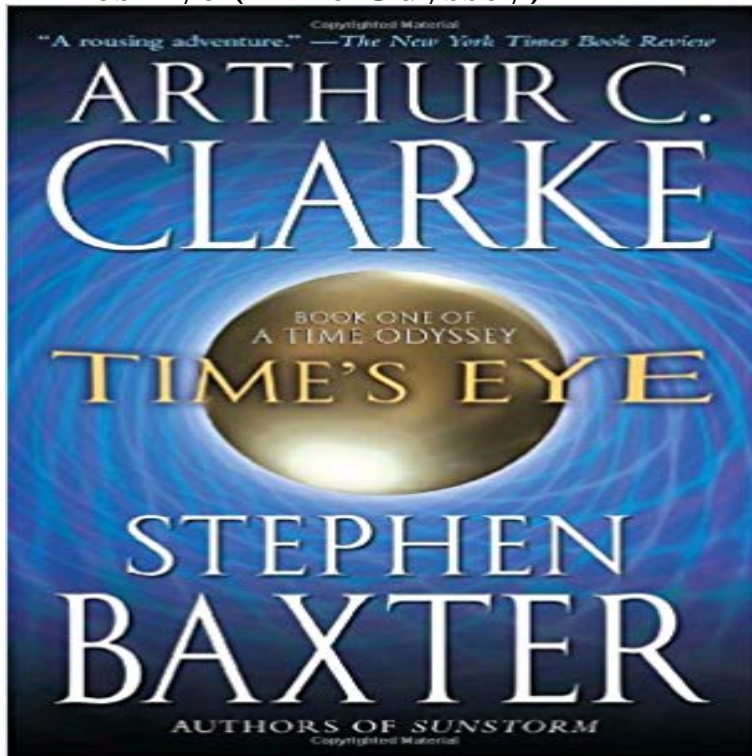


Times Eye (Time Odyssey)
