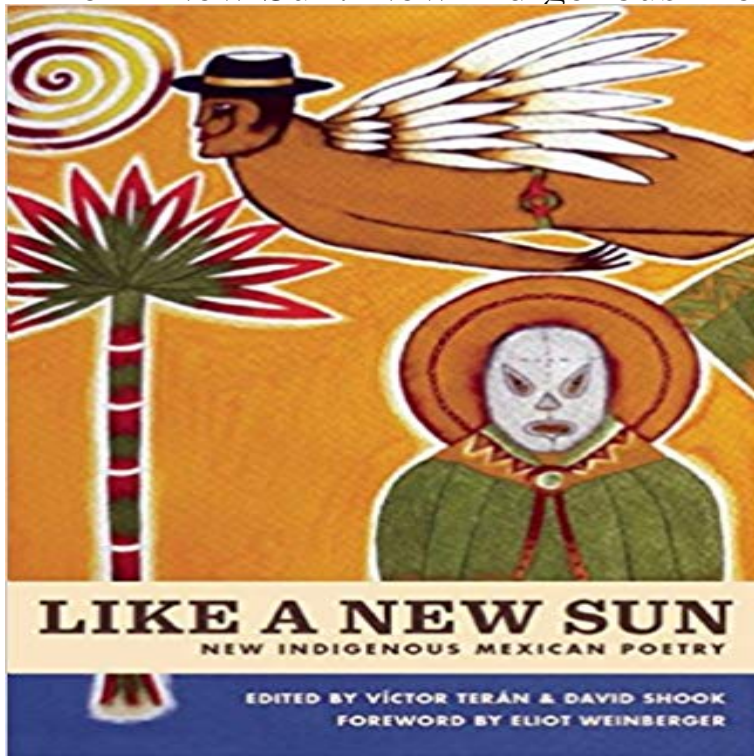


Like A New Sun: New Indigenous Mexican Poetry
