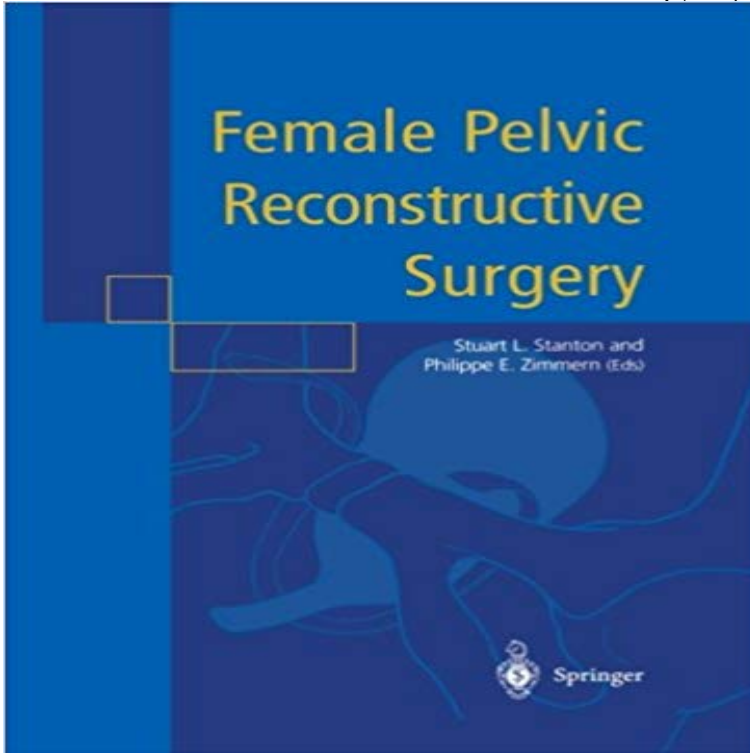


## Female Pelvic Reconstructive Surgery
