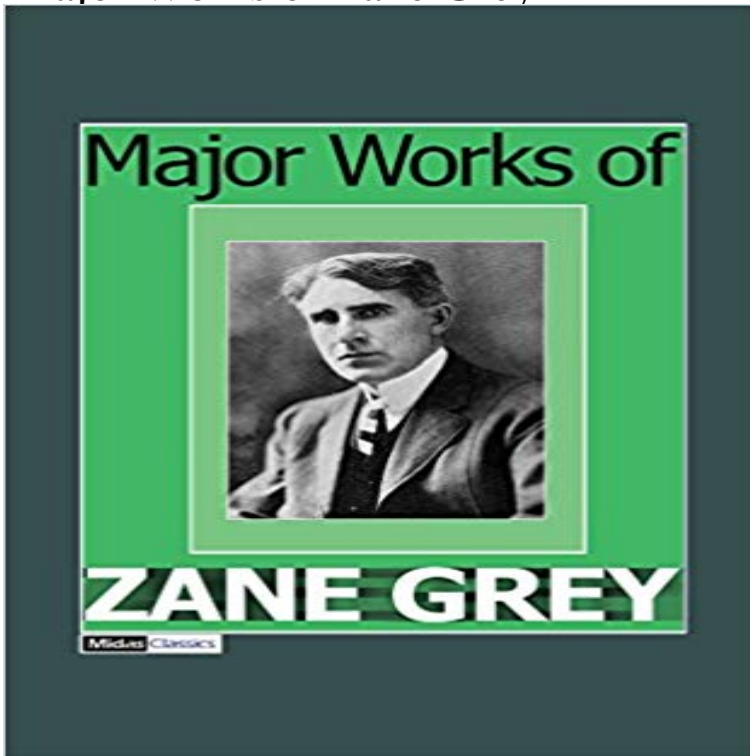


Major Works of Zane Grey
